We have had a very busy time in going through the processes for our School Captains, House Captains and Junior School Council Leaders. I am looking forward to hearing who our leaders are and their plans to achieve their goals for 2023.

#### A key message for this week is the importance of attending school every day.

Going to school every day is the single most important part of your child's education. Students learn new things at school every day. We want our students to get a great education, and the building blocks for a great education begin with students coming to school each and every day.

0-5 days: A child with this attendance rate is able to take advantage of the teaching and learning opportunities available to them.

6-10 days: A child with this attendance rate could miss over half a year of learning between Prep and Year 6.

11-20 days: A child with this attendance rate could miss out on up to one- and one-half years of learning between Prep and Year 6.

20+ days: A child with this attendance rate could miss over one- and one-half years of learning between Prep and Year 6.

Remember: There is a direct link between school attendance and achievement, not only at school, but also later in life.


