DRIVER SAFETY AROUND OUR SCHOOL

You can help to make our school a safer place by obeying the road rules and being patient and understanding at the peak traffic times of 8:50am and 3:20pm.

You can do this by:

- Obeying parking signs and road rules. This includes not making U turns in front of the school where such turns are not permitted.
- Observing the school zone 40kmph speed limit on school days.
- Parking a little way from the school and walking to collect your child
- Being patient at peak times. More children around schools are injured at the start of school rather than at the end of the day due to parents rushing to get to work.

Our children need to be safe and we can all play our part by:

- ❖ Obeying the road rules
- ❖ Parking and walking
- ❖ Being patient
