

We are a School Wide Positive Behaviour School (SWPBS)



MHPS is a School Wide Positive behaviour School.

We teach, model and promote the resolving of conflict

or issues in ways that are non-violent.

We ask parents to reinforce the school values by teaching children to prevent conflict.

How?

This model can help students resolve conflicts on their own: **1.STOP.** Don't let things get out of control. Take a step back and try to calm down, since anger makes conflicts more difficult to resolve.

- 2.SAY what the conflict is about. Make sure you both have a clear understanding of what is causing the disagreement and clarify what each of you wants or doesn't want.
- **3.THINK** of positive options. What's a fair solution that meets both of your needs?
- 4.CHOOSE a positive option that everyone can agree on.
- **5.RESPECT** the opinions of others, even if you can't agree. Effective conflict resolution also requires children to remain positive, patient, and sincere.

Some tips on what NOT to do include:

- Resorting to name-calling
- Using physical violence
- Interrupting the other person
- Refusing to listen
- Insulting someone's family

FREE WEBINAR INTEREST BASED LEARNING




