

SWPBS at home


We encourage all parents, carers and members of the Meadow Heights PS community to discuss our school values and positive behaviour expectations with your children.

Teaching behaviours that we expect to see works best when there is consistency across home and school settings. SWPBS is an approach to help all students learn to self-manage behaviour. Family involvement is a key feature and important in all aspects of SWPBS. A strong partnership between school and family is important because when families are involved, outcomes for students are better.

You can be involved in SWPBS by:

- Familiarising yourself with the SWPBS Behaviour matrix (below)
- reading materials distributed by the school via Compass verbally acknowledging and recognising when your child meets expected behaviours
- responding consistently and with meaningful consequences when problem behaviour occurs.






















































With higher UV levels from September onwards it is important to use a combination of sunprotection measures to minimise the risk of skin and eye damage and skin cancer.
