
Our HUB


This is some of our data showing the number of people visiting the HUB to attend programs or activities. It is part of the Mid-year HUB report. It shows how important our HUB is to the school community.






25th August to celebrate book week. Students will have the opportunity to share in their classrooms who they dressed up as and why this book character is their favourite.




























2023 Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey
