- Certain

- Likely
- Probably

- Might happen
- Possible

- Unlikely

- Impossible
- Won't happen



I will drink water



It will likely be warm in Summer



It might rain in Autumn



It is unlikely that I will fly a plane



It is impossible that a pig will fly

What does this all mean?

- Will happen
- Certain

It is going to happen – 100%

- Likely
- Probably

There is a pretty good chance it is going to happen – 90%

- Might happen
- Possible

It could happen – 60 % chance

- Unlikely

There isn't a good chance that this will happen – 10 % chance

- Impossible
- Won't happen

It definitely will not / cannot happen – 0% chance
